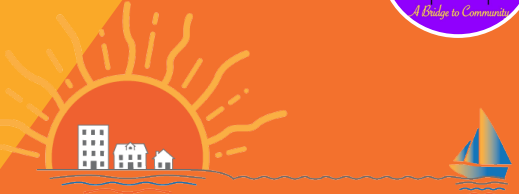

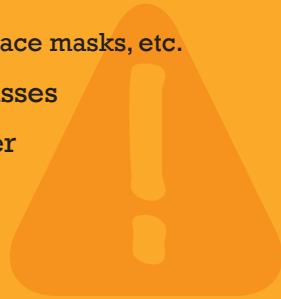

Go Bag - Include 3 days worth

Shelter in Place Bag - Include 7 days worth

- ☐ Non-perishable food (ready to eat)
- ☐ 1 Gallon of water per person per day
- ☐ Medications
Prescription and over-the-counter
- ☐ Medical supplies
Hearing aids, syringes, face masks, etc.
- ☐ Eye care products/glasses
- ☐ Cellphone and charger
- ☐ Change of clothing
- ☐ Closed-toed shoes
- ☐ Hand sanitizer/wipes
- ☐ Travel-size soaps, shampoos, lotions
- ☐ Blanket or sleeping bag
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Toilet paper
